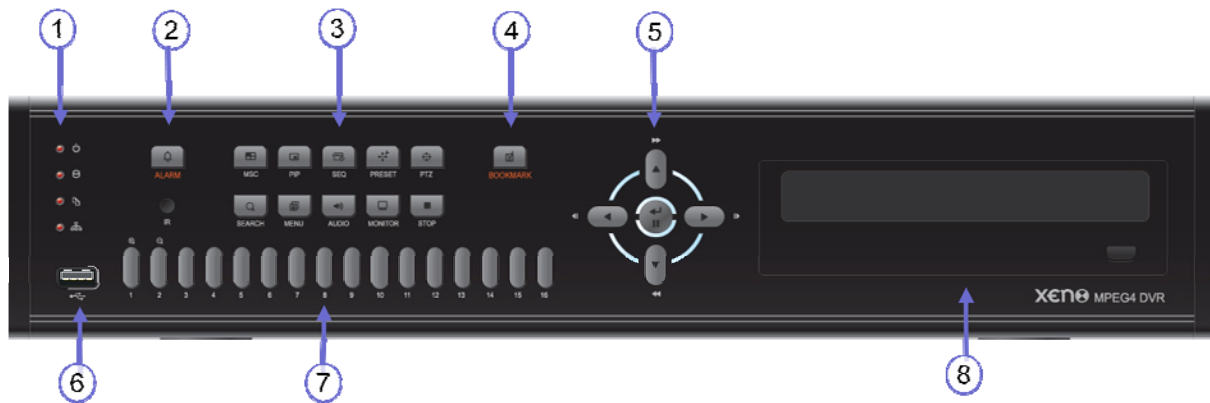




XDR Range quick user guide



1. LED indicators
2. Alarm clear button
3. Function keys controlling Screen views and PTZ functions
4. Bookmark key to tag disk at area of interest
5. Direction keys for navigating menus and controlling playback
6. USB port for downloading recorded data and upgrading unit firmware
7. Camera selection Keys
8. CD/DVD-RW for the downloading of recorded data

LIVE CONTROL

1. Select relevant camera button



2. To display a sequence of cameras press the sequence button



3. To select a split screen press the split screen button



4. To tag the disk with a marker press the bookmark button



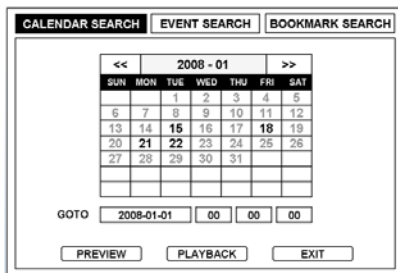
5. To select the Picture in picture Mode press the PIP button



Playback and Downloading

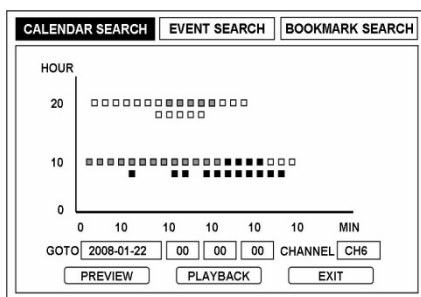
The searching is most easily carried out using the mouse:

1. With the cursor on the screen right click, a menu will appear, select the SEARCH option, the following page will be displayed:



- << Shows previous month.
- >> Shows next month.
- go to Date, Time
 - go to 1st box : Shows date in YY-MM-DD format to search.
 - go to 2nd box : Shows Hour to search. Change Hour from 0~23 by clicking the box.
 - go to 3rd box : Shows Minute to search. Change Minute from 0~59 by clicking the box.
 - go to 4th box : Shows Second to search. Change Second from 0~59 by clicking the box.
- Preview : Playback for 10 seconds from the set date/time and return to calendar search.
- Playback : Playback from the set date/time.
- Exit : Exit search menu.

Select the relevant day from the calendar, the following page will be displayed:



- If dots are white, it means it contains recorded data. If dots are black, there is no recorded data.
- Select white dot, or input time in 'go to' box and press Preview / Playback to begin playback.
- When white dot is selected, Hour/Minute on the 'go to' boxes change automatically, but user should input second manually.
- Date box : By clicking this box, you can move to Calendar search menu, where you can set date.
- Channel : In case ALL is selected :
 - White dots contain recorded data.
 - Black dots don't contain recorded data.
- In case certain channel number is selected:
 - Red dots contain recorded data for panic recording.
 - Blue dots contain recorded data for schedule recording.
 - Green dots contain recorded data for event recording.
 - Black dots don't contain recorded data.

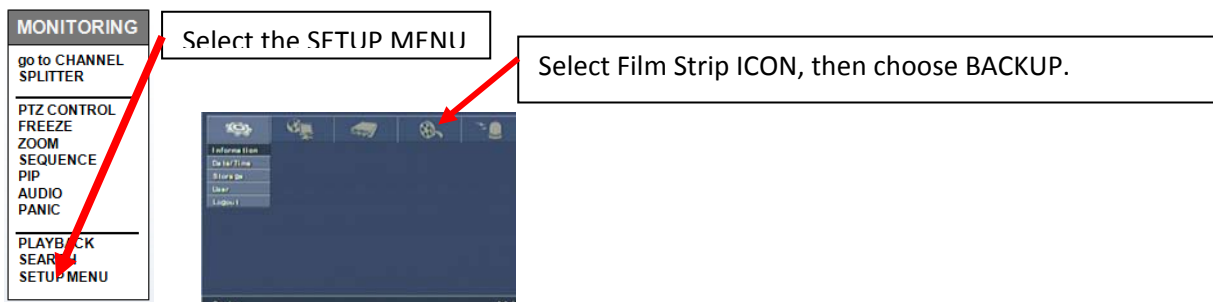
*1 dot equals 1 minute.

Select the time required and click PLAYBACK

Note: more advanced searches can be carried out using the Event and Bookmark tabs, please refer to manual for guidance.

2. To download an event once it has been found

Enter the Main MENU, by right clicking on the mouse, the following will appear



A Window will appear that offers the option of CD/DVD or USB port.

Enter the Start and Stop times and dates required, then Click START. The information will be burned to the selected Media.
